The Fimiston Open Pit, known as the Super Pit, is Australia's largest open cut gold mine.

The Super Pit is located in Kalgoorlie, Western Australia.



The pit is oblong in shape and is approximately 3.5 kilometres long, 1.5 kilometres wide and 570 metres deep.

At these dimensions, it is large enough to be seen from space.

Mining Terms

Overburden – soil and rock overlying a useful mineral deposit.

Spoils – overburden discarded as waste material

Tailings – the unused materials left on land from dredging ore deposits from streams

Top Star Mine Dump was converted into a drive-in movie theater. **With rising gold prices, the discarded tailings were reprocessed for remnant gold.** This was photographed in 2010 with downtown Johannesburg in the background.

FLORRIE EVANS-- The teenager
(16-18 years old) from New Quay, Wales who
publicly confessed that she loved the Lord
Jesus Christ with all her heart.

This she did in the morning youth meeting
at her church.

Her simple words were **the spark that lit**
revival fire in her church and in the west
Wales area, a fire that would soon become
national in its scope. These words spoken on
Sunday, February 14, 1904 were to be the first
drops of an international downpour.
